Policy for Establishing Affinity Groups

Adopted by the Executive Board of the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Northern Chautauqua (UUCNC), June 2013

In order to establish an affinity group, a UUCNC member in good standing will submit a proposal for Executive Board approval demonstrating the group's connection with UU principles and the UUCNC mission, and will provide oversight and communication for the group. The group will be encouraged to meet in public spaces as much as possible to promote wider participation.

Policy on Affinity Groups

Adopted by the Executive Board of the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Northern Chautauqua (UUCNC), January 2014

Affinity Groups shall periodically provide update reports to the Board, a minimum of one report to be submitted prior to the Annual Meeting. These updates shall come from the group's contact person, who is a UUCNC member.

Affinity Groups shall designate one person to participate in Coordinating Council.

In the event that reports are not submitted, there is no longer a member designated as the contact for the group, or the group has not met during the church year, the Affinity Group will be considered disbanded. Disbanded Affinity Groups can become re-established should interest arise by following the procedures found in the Policy for Establishing Affinity Groups (*above*).
