Policy on Minor Child Members

Adopted by the Executive Board of the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Northern Chautauqua (UUCNC), February 2015

When individuals with minor children join our congregation, the children are welcome to sign the membership book and be recognized in a worship service along with the joining adult(s). According to our by-laws, one must be 18 years of age to have voting privileges. Upon the age of 18, these individuals who previously joined as minor children may then join as adult members, according to the procedure in the congregational bylaws.
